Frequently Asked Questions

Do I have to have a library card to sign up?

No, you do not have to have a library card to participate in either the reading challenge or the events. It is easy to sign up for one though!

Do I have to sign up for the reading challenge to come to any of the events?

No, though they are both part of the umbrella term “Summer Reading Program,” the events and the reading challenge are separate. You do not have to sign up for the reading challenge to participate in any events.

My child doesn't know how to read. Can we still participate?

Yes! This program is for kids ages 0-12, so kids who don't know how to read are encouraged to sign up! Being read to or reading with a grown up is very valuable for developing those early literacy skills.

Do audiobooks count?

Yes, listening to audiobooks counts for this challenge!

Can I complete the challenge more than once?

Yes, kids can complete the reading challenge more than once; however, after the first reading log they will only be able to earn more tickets toward the grand prizes, not the earned prizes that include the ice cream coupons and free books.
