
Teen Room Policy

Code of Conduct

1. The Teen Room is open at the discretion of Library staff. If the Teen room cannot be staffed, it may close without notice. Please respect this decision and leave the room if asked.
 - a. The Teen Room is open to students in 6th-12th grade.
 - b. Supervising adults are welcome, but teen patrons have priority for computers and other teen room services.
 - c. Teen room users must keep hands and feet (and other body parts) to themselves. This includes PDA.
 - d. Do not bring bikes, skateboards, scooters, etc... into the library. Library staff is not responsible for any personal valuables inside or outside of the library.

2. Food is only allowed at the maker table.
 - a. Snacks are allowed, but please do not have food delivered to the library.
 - b. Beverages must be in a sealed container. No cans, no gas station or fast food cups with straws.
 - c. Clean up after yourself.

3. Use PG-13 language. Keep in mind that not everyone who uses the teen room is OK with rough language.
 - a. Any language that disparages another person or group of people will not be tolerated. You know what this means, don't push it.

4. Computer use is limited to two, 1-hour sessions per day. If people are waiting to use a computer, please limit use to 1 hour.
 - a. Do not use another patron's library card to log onto a computer. If you do not have a library card, ask a staff member to sign you on to a computer, or apply for a "Digital Only" card.
 - b. As of September 7th, 2022, video game consoles will only be allowed on the large TVs. Do not plug them into the computer monitors.

- c. You may use your own keyboard and mouse, but you must plug the original equipment back in when you leave.

- 5. Teen room activities are always optional, but please respect those who choose to participate. Keep noise levels at a minimum while programs are happening.

These rules are subject to change. If you are asked to leave the Teen Room and the Library, please comply quickly. In most cases, you may return the next day. In some cases, you may be asked to stay away from the library for a longer time. Repeated violations will result in being trespassed from the library for 30 days.
