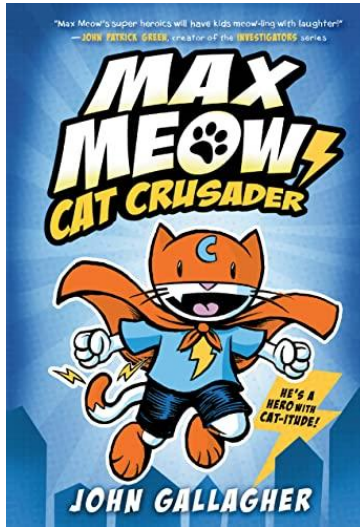
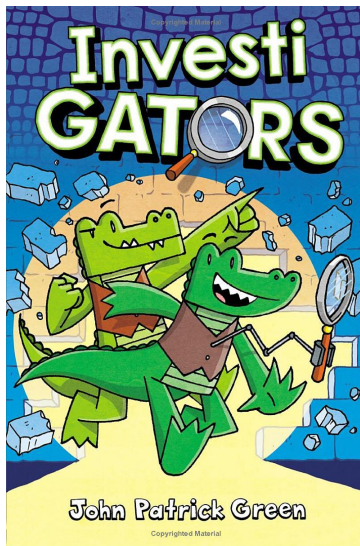

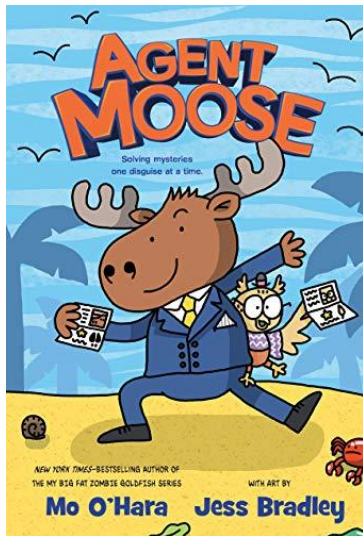
Max Meow: Cat Crusaders - John Gallagher

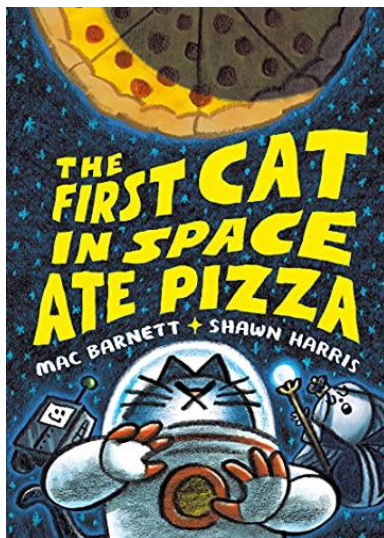
InvestiGATORS - John Patrick Green

Agent Moose - Mo O'Hara

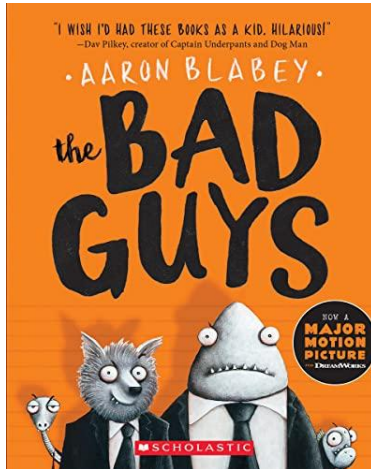
